

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: Suction hose to pump must be a wire braid hose; minimum 1" I.D. for 7 & 9 gpm pumps; 11/4" I.D. for 12 & 17 gpm pumps. Installations with smaller suction hoses will void the pump warranty.

- 1. Disconnect battery.
- 2. Remove fan and fan shroud.
- 3. Remove bolts from air conditioner (11) and radiator hose support (21).
- 4. Remove power steering pulley (26).
- 5. Remove bolts (12, 13) and nut (14) mounting air conditioner bracket to engine.
- 6. Remove power steering pump from engine (2 nuts on back side).
- 7. Remove engine lifting bracket (24) behind power steering pump.
- 8. Cut lifting bracket as shown in fig. 2. Discard upper slotted portion.
- 9. Replace lifting bracket back on engine.
- 10. Replace power steering pump and secure with OEM nuts.
- 11. Bolt DewEze air conditioner bracket (23) in place using OEM bolts (12, 13) and nut (14).
- 12. Replace power steering pulley.
- 13. Bolt air conditioner compressor in place on bracket with only two bolts (11) on passenger side.
- 14. Cut radiator hose support cradle off of OEM bracket as shown in fig. 1. Bolt back on air conditioner bracket using OEM bolt (21).
- 15. Bolt on pump mounting plate (1) using two 3/8 x 1 1/2 socket head bolts (9) in holes (A and B).
- 16. Place tabs (2) on top of pump plate (1) and air conditioner compressor at holes (C, D, E, F) using OEM bolts (11) in air conditioner compressor and 3/8 x 1 wiz bolts (10) in pump plate.
- 17. Place footmount on plate using four 3/8 x 1 1/4 bolts (18) with 3/8 lock washers (19) and 3/8 flat washer (20).
- 18. Mount pump on footmount using two 3/8 x 1 1/4 bolts (18) with 3/8 lock washers (19). Do not tighten.
- 19. Place hose holder (3) on top mounting bolt of pump, tighten bolts.

- 20. Mount clutch coil (8) using four wiz bolts provided with clutch. Mount clutch pulley using bolt and heavy flat washer provided with clutch.
- 21. Bolt idler pulley (5) using 7/16 x 2 3/4 bolt (16), 7/16 flat washer (17), and bushing (4) into pump plate at hole (H).
- 22. Bolt idler pulley (5) using 10mm x 60mm bolt (15), 7/16 flat washer (17), and bushing (4) into air conditioner bracket at hole (G).
- 23. Install belt (27) as shown in fig. 3.
- 24. Reconnect the battery.
- 25. Run the engine and check for any clearances or alignment problems. Adjust as needed.
- 26. Place fan and shroud into position.
- 27. Run the engine again, checking for any problems.
