



Clutch Pump Kit #700090 Chevy 454 With A/C

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: Suction hose to pump must be a wire braid hose; minimum 1" I.D. for 7 & 9 gpm pumps; 11/4" I.D. pumps; 11/4" I.D. for 12 & 17 gpm pumps. Installations with smaller suction hoses will void the pump warranty.

- 1. Disconnect battery.
- 2. Remove fan and fan shroud.
- 3. Remove upper radiator hose.
- 4. Remove 4 bolts holding air conditioner compressor. These will not be used again.
- 5. Mount pump mounting plate (1) to angle bracket (2) at holes A using two 3/8 x 1 socket head bolts (11) and two 3/8 nuts (12).
- 6. Lift up compressor and place angle bracket and pump plate assembly at holes C and place two .25" thick spacers (29) on holes G on air conditioner mounting bracket. Set compressor back down.
- 7. Place two 10mm x 100mm bolts (14) in compressor in holes G in passenger side only. Do not tighten.
- 8. Place tab (3) on top rear of pump plate at hole H using 3/8 x 1 socket head bolt (11) and a 10mm x 110mm bolt (30) through other end of tab into compressor.
- 9. Place idler mount tab (4) on top front of pump plate at hole B using 3/8 x 1 1/2 socket head bolt (13) and a 10mm x 110mm bolt (30) through other end of tab into compressor at hole C. 5/8 tapped hole is offset closer to one end of tab. Mount tab so hole is offset toward pump plate.
- 10. Mount one cast idler pulley (31) with snap ring facing forward, away from engine, at hole D using bushing (5) on back side with 10mm x 60mm bolt (15) and 7/16 flat washer (18).
- 11. Mount the other cast idler pulley (31) with snap ring facing forward, away from engine, at hole E using bushing (5) on back side with 7/16 x 2 3/4 bolt (16) and 7/16 flat washer (18).
- 12. Mount plastic idler (7) at hole F using .55" thick spacer (6) on back side with 5/8 x 3 bolt (17).
- 13. Place footmount (9) on plate (1) using four 3/8 x 1 1/4 bolts (19) with 3/8 lock washers (20) and 3/8 flat washers (21). Just make bolts snug. Do not tighten all the way.
- 14. Mount pump (8) on footmount using two 3/8 x 1 1/4 bolts (19) with 3/8 lock washers (20).
- 15. Mount clutch coil (10) using four small wiz bolts provided with clutch. Mount clutch pulley using bolt and heavy flat washer provided with clutch.
- 16. Install belt (22) as shown in Fig. 3.
- 17. Use a straight edge to align clutch pulley with other pulleys so belt runs straight. Tighten footmount bolts.
- 18. Refer to Fig. 2 for the following: Insert hose adapter (26) into long end of long hose (14.25", item 27). Secure with hose clamp (24).

- 19. Insert hose splice (23) into other end of hose (27). Place long end of short hose (9.25", item 28) over hose splice. Secure these with hose clamps (24).
- 20. Push short end of hose (28) onto water pump, securing with OEM hose clamp (25).
- 21. Reconnect the battery.
- 22. Run the engine and check for any clearance or alignment problems. Adjust as needed.
- 23. Replace fan and shroud.
- 24. Run the engine again, checking for any problems.

NOTE: The small cast idler pulleys (31) replace two plastic idler pulleys (same as 7). This was done so the belt is not so tight and is easier to install.
