

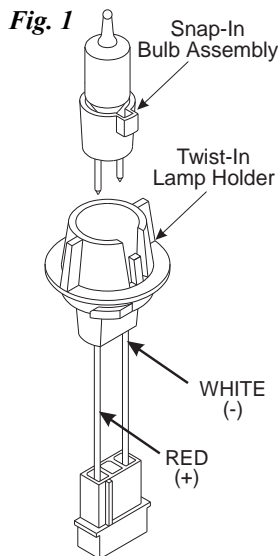

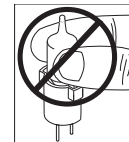

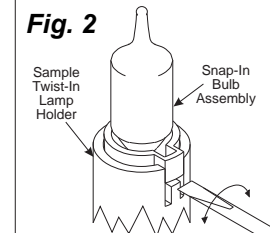

If the bulb cannot be accessed by a screwdriver, as shown in Fig. 2, remove the lamp holder from the reflector before proceeding with bulb replacement.

### To replace a Snap-In bulb....

1. Be sure the power to the lamp is turned off.
2. Insert a small, flat-blade screwdriver into the space between the twist-in lamp holder and the snap-in bulb assembly.
3. Gently rotate the screwdriver as shown in Fig. 2. Repeat this action until the bulb is loose.
4. Pull the bulb in an upward direction until it is free.
5. Insert the alignment tab of the new bulb into the bulb holder and press downwards to lock the new bulb into place.

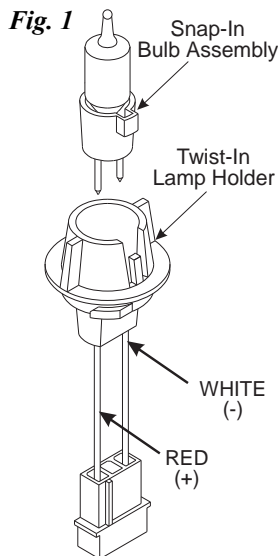

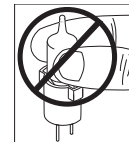

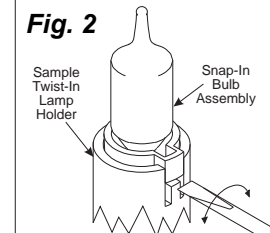
