- Remove the retaining nut and washer from the sector arm.
- 2 Back out the forcing screw. Slip casting over the pitman arm until the forcing screw lines up with the center of the sector shaft.
- 3 Once the tool is properly positioned on the pitman arm, apply ½" drive impact to the forcing screw until the pitman arm is removed from the sector shaft.
