






INSTRUCTIONS


- **1.** Unscrew two bolts under the skid plates and let it swing loose temporarily in order to gain access to the side of the frames. It is NOT necessary to remove the bumper.
- **2.** Remove the tow hooks (if your vehicle option is equipped with them).
- **3.** Hold the PS Bracket (2) up against the passenger side frame rail, aligning with the existing hole in the bottom. Secure the Bracket using one $\frac{1}{2}$ -13 x 1.5 bolt (4), one washer (6) and one locknut (8). FIG 1



- **4.** On the side of the frame, secure the Bracket using one $\frac{1}{2}$ -13 with handle (7) bolts, one flat washer (6), one lock washer (10), and one easynut (8). Then, secure the other hole with one $\frac{1}{2}$ -13 x 4.0 bolt, one flat washer outside & inside (6), and one locknut (8).
- **5.** In the front of the frame-using the PS Bracket as a template, drill one hole with 9/16 diameter clearance. Secure the Bracket using one $\frac{1}{2}$ -13 x 1.5 bolt (4), one flat washer (6) and one locknut (8). FIG 2



- 6. Repeat steps 3-5 above for DS bracket.
- 7. Mount the Pushbar (1) in place between the two side plates using eight ½-13x1-1/2 bolts and locknuts. The centerline of the pushbar crosspin should be approximately 9-3/4" from the ground. Improper mounting height will result in uneven cutting edge wear.



- **8.** Torque all fasteners as shown in the chart. Check and re-torque all fasteners after 5 hours of usage to ensure safe plow operation.
- **9.** It may be helpful to route the plow and light control harnesses at this point, prior to bumper reinstallation.
- **10.** Reinstall the plastic air damp touching the push bar ears. It is necessary to trim the plastic air damp to acquire optimum height for the push bar.

WARNING

This may require weighing the vehicle and adding ballast as necessary. It may also limit payload capacity of the vehicle. It is the operator's responsibility to verify that these ratings are not exceeded.

CAUTION

- Read all instructions prior to assembly
- It is critical that all fasteners be properly torqued for safe plow operation see chart above.
- Fasteners should be retorqued after 5-8 hours of plow use

FULL ONE-YEAR WARRANTY

Manufacturer will repair, or at manufacturer's discretion will replace any part of this snowplow which proves to be defective in workmanship or material under normal use for a period of one year from the date of delivery to the original purchaser.
