



User Instructions:

Mounting Your Cycle Loader Mounting Kit:

Begin by choosing the location to place your Cycle Loader and Cycle Loader Mounting Kit. Please refer to the mounting configurations 1, 2 & 3 depicted in the photos on the front page of this sheet. Once you have chosen a location, set the Mounting Kit Base (A) in place and mark **two** of the six hole locations. Remove the Mounting Kit Base and drill the holes using the appropriate 5/16" hole size drill bit. Next, place the Mounting Kit Base back t the desired mounting location, insert the 5/16' screws provided (F), washers (G), lock nuts (E), and tightening the Mounting Kit Base in-place. At this point, you should drill the remaining four 5/16"holes and securely tighten the Mounting Kit Base to the mounting surface. You are now ready to attach the Mounting Kit Bracket (B) to the Mounting Kit Base as shown in configuration #3. Using the short 5/16" screw (C), washer (D), lock nuts (E), attach end securely tighten the two bracket together. At this point, you should be ready to place the Cycle Loader in position for transportation.

Securing Your Cycle Loader in Position for Transport:

Lift up the unit by the front hook with the top side facing you and roll the unit between the Mounting Kit Bracket. Secure your Cycle Loader with the two 10" pins provided by inserting them through the Mounting Kit Bracket and unit making sure not to forget to insert the hitch pin clips on the ends of the pins (as shown in Figure 2). For added security, replace one pin with two heavy duty pad locks. Tighten the lower wheel brakes for extra stability. Store ramp in toolbox making sure not to miss-place it.

Remove Cradle pin and position Cradle over the Front-Stop following your "cradle removal manual" which came with your Cycle Loader **in reverse order.** Lower the Front-Stop channel until you can re-insert the cradle pin through the unit and cradle securing the two together in a lowered position. Next, re-insert the Front-Stop pin so it remains with the unit making sure not to leave out the hitch pin clip by re-inserting it into the pin. Secure Cradle and Front-Stop to the unit by wrapping the Velcro strap or bungee cord provided around the entire unit making sure to over-lap the Front-Stop Channel securely to prevent the channel and cradle from bouncing against each other while driving. Place the second strap around the lower portion of the entire unit and mounting bracket to prevent the Cycle Loader from jarring around while the vehicle is in motion. Be sure to use these straps to avoid any vibration that could eventually cause damage due to any hardware coming loose over time.

Always make sure that all fasteners are tight and all pins are in place prior to use. Understand the limitations of this product and do not exceed these limitations. Always make sure that the unit's cradle settings are optimum for the tire size of the motorcycle before use. For bikes with very low fenders and or cowlings, a custom cradle may be purchased fitted to specific tire sizes, so as not to make contact. For standard sport bike front wheel combinations, the 1, 2, 3, front settings may be suitable.
